## Limble CMMS

▲ Professional Plating recently implemented a new Preventive Maintenance platform to aid us in performing and tracking our maintenance needs. The program, Limble, is a Computerized Maintenance Management System or CMMS. It is a software package that maintains a computer database of information about an organization's maintenance operations. This information is intended to help maintenance workers do their jobs more effectively by for example, determining which machines require maintenance and providing detailed pictorial work instructions to perform the job.



Professional Plating tracks over 650 preventive maintenance items for our process equipment. Tracking was previously done on paper, which had to be gone through and updated on a weekly basis. Updates to maintenance item status' are now being done automatically by the maintenance technicians on I-pads as the tasks are done, giving us real time updates. We will also be using this program to track spare part inventory, safety training events, and tank maintenance. The program will give the management team insight for scheduling down time for maintenance items that cannot be performed while a machine is in operation which will eliminate maintenance items from becoming overdue due to scheduling conflicts.
